What are the requirements?

Key Requirements:

- Experience in 2D/3D building & interior design.
- Ability to work independently.
- High attention to details.
- Applicant is already based in Denmark (with work-permit).
- Passion for climbing is a massive plus.
- Proficient English is required, and it is the company language at Beta Boulders

- No minimum work experience is required (we welcome master student applicants as well).
- Position is based in Copenhagen, but travelling might be required.
